# 0. INTRODUCTION

### 0.1. THE ATTRIBUTE OF GOODNESS

- Goodness and <u>being</u> (the medievals understood God's goodness, in terms of being: goodness and being are interchangeable)
- "combination" of attributes (goodness and )
- "The message that "God is light" needs to be compared with the declarations elsewhere by John that "God is spirit" (John 4:24) and that "God is love" (1 John 4:8). All three stress the immateriality of God and the "Godness" of God—viz., God in his essence. Light emphasizes especially the **splendor** and **glory** of God, the **truthfulness** of God, and his **purity**."

# 0.2. THE LIGHT – PHYSICAL AND SPIRITUAL

- But if light travelled at a constant speed, then not enough time has passed since the Big Bang for photons to reach the edges of the visible universe, resulting in what scientists call the Horizon Problem.<sup>2</sup>
- "light" → metaphor
- connotations: glory; truth; holiness; joy; life; guidance...

### 1. GOD AS LIGHT

#### 1.1. RADIATING POWER

- dynamic; radiating; (→ the Sun nuclear fusion) "process" (not processual theology)
- Dt 4:24 For the LORD your God is a consuming fire (יהוה אֱלֹהֶיךְ אֵשׁ אֹּכְלָה), a jealous God.
- Heb 12:29 for our God is a consuming fire (ὁ θεὸς ἡμῶν πῦρ καταναλίσκον).

# 1.2. GIVING LIFE

- **Ps 56:13** For you have delivered my soul from death, yes, my feet from falling, that I may walk before **God** in the **light** of life
- **2Cor 4:6** For **God**, who said, "Let **light** shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the **light** of the knowledge of the glory of **God** in the face of Jesus Christ.

### 1.3. CAUSING JOY

God's blessedness in himself, is that attribute, whereby, being for ever free from all evil, and having all fulness of perfection and sufficiency in himself, he doth most perfectly and unchangeably enjoy himself.<sup>3</sup>

- Ps 31:16 Make your face shine on your servant; save me in your steadfast love!
- Ps 67:1 May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face to shine upon us
- **Ps 4:6-7** There are many who say, "Who will show us some good? <u>Lift up the light of your face</u> upon us, O LORD!" <sup>7</sup> You have put <u>more **joy** in my heart</u> than they have when their grain and wine abound.

Eph 5:14 anything that becomes visible is light

- → reality (**Is 42:6-7** I will give you as a <u>covenant</u> for the people, a <u>light for the nations</u>, <sup>7</sup> to **open** the **eyes** that are blind, <u>to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon</u>, from the prison those who sit in <u>darkness</u>)
- → freedom to "breathe" (**Ps 118:5** Out of my distress [הַמֵּצַר] I called on the LORD; the LORD answered me and set me free → and set me in a large place [בַּמַרְחַב].)
- $\rightarrow$  perspective (hierarchy of beings)

# 2.2. OTHERS (OTHER THINGS)

- → relationships
- → community; fellowship (**1John 1:3** that you too may have <u>fellowship</u> with us; and indeed **our fellowship** is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ)

### 2.3. ORIENTATION (TRUTH)

- darkness  $\rightarrow$  death
- $\rightarrow$  life (Ps 36:9[10] For with you is the fountain of life; in your light do we see light [נראה־אוֹר].)
- → self-knowledge (confession) (Ps 32:3-5 For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.

  For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer. Selah

  I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity)
- James 5:16 ... confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, ...1 John 1:8-9 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- **Eph 5:14** ...for anything that becomes **visible is** light. Therefore it says, "Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you.

# 2.4. ACTIVITY (ENERGY, WORK)

- $\rightarrow$  acceptance of love
- **John 8:12** Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever <u>follows me</u> will not walk in darkness, but will have the <u>light of life</u>.

#### 3. TO REMEMBER

- To really know God is to experience spiritual light.
- God as light gives joy in holiness, fellowship in truth.
