- glory, fame, significance \rightarrow the strongest spiritual craving \rightarrow stealing from God \rightarrow IDOLATRY
- GLORY \rightarrow excellence \rightarrow admiration \rightarrow fame \rightarrow praise \rightarrow submission
- glory: the sum of all God's attributes as he is known to other beings

0.1. THE WORDS

- weight, burden – (impressive) appearance, weightiness – give honor to Yahweh

δόξα – opinion, judgment, view; (Even in classic Greek do,xa is a word of wide significance, ranging from one's private opinion, fancy, to <u>public opinion</u>, repute, renown \dots^1

0.2. THE ESSENCE

- the GREATNESS of God in His *OTHERNESS*... → HIS IDENTITY, personal presence
 - holiness \rightarrow difference in purity and being;
 - glory \rightarrow difference in power and deeds
- 1Ki 8:11 ... the priests could not stand to minister because of the <u>cloud</u>, for the glory of the LORD (כבוד־יָהוָה) filled the house of the LORD.
 - Is 4:5 Then the LORD will create over the whole site of Mount Zion and over her assemblies a cloud by day, and smoke and the shining of a flaming fire by night; for over all the glory there will be a canopy (הַפָה).
 - Rev 15:8 the sanctuary was filled with smoke from the glory of God (ἐγεμίσθη ὁ ναὸς καπνοῦ ἐκ τῆς δόξης τοῦ θεοῦ) and from his power, and no one could enter the sanctuary

1. GLORY – WHO GOD IS

1.1. AS REVEALED TO MOSES

- Ex 33:18 "Please show me your glory." (הַרְאַנִי נָא אֶת־פְּבֹרֵך) →
- Ex 34:6-8 "The LORD, the LORD, a God <u>merciful</u> and <u>gracious</u>, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast <u>love and faithfulness</u>, ⁷ keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will <u>by no means clear the guilty</u>, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and the fourth generation." ⁸ And Moses quickly bowed his head toward the earth and worshiped (ווקר אַרְצָה ווִשְׁתָחוֹ).

1.2. AS REVEALED IN THE BOOK OF REVELATION

Rev 21:23 And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light (δόξα τοῦ θ∈οῦ ἐφώτισεν αὐτήν), and its lamp (λύχνος) is the Lamb

2. GLORY – WHAT GOD DOES

2.1. CREATION \rightarrow **NATURE**

- **Ps 19:1** The heavens declare the glory of God (מְסַפְּרִים כְּבוֹד־אֵל), and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.
- Ps 139:14 I praise you, for <u>I am fearfully and wonderfully made</u> (אוֹרָאוֹת נִפְלֵיתִי).
- Is 6:3 "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" (מְלֹא כְּלֹ־הָאֶָרֶץ כְּבוֹרוֹ)

(1) Greatness \rightarrow power, size, (2) Diversity \rightarrow varieties of beings; behaviours; (3) Complexity \rightarrow subatomic particles (string theory) \leftrightarrow galaxies...

2.2. HISTORY \rightarrow PROVIDENCE

• Rom 11:32-36 For God has consigned all to disobedience, that he may have mercy on all. ³³ Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How <u>unsearchable</u> are his judgments and how <u>inscrutable</u> his ways! (βάθος πλούτου καὶ σοφίας καὶ γνώσεως θεοῦ· ὡς ἀνεξεραύνητα τὰ κρίματα αὐτοῦ καὶ ἀνεξιχνίαστοι αἱ ὁδοὶ αὐτοῦ.) ³⁴ "For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?" ³⁵ "Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?" ³⁶ For from him and through him and to him are all things. <u>To him be glory forever</u> (αὐτῷ ἡ δόξα εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας). Amen → Jer 9:23-24 Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, ²⁴ but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am the LORD who practices <u>steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth</u> (תְּכֶּר מִשְׁפְּם וֹצֶּרְקָה בָּאֶרֶק), declares the LORD."

2.3. MIRACLES \rightarrow WONDER

 John 2:11 This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory (ἐφανέρωσεν τὴν δόξαν αὐτοῦ). And his disciples believed in him

2.4. SALVATION \rightarrow THE CROSS

- \rightarrow Ex 34:6-8
- John 13:29-31 Judas ...after receiving the morsel of bread, he immediately went out. And it was night. ³¹ When he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now is the Son of Man <u>glorified</u>, and God is <u>glorified</u> in him (νῦν ἐδοξάσθη ὁ υἱὸς τοῦ ἀνθρώπου καὶ ὁ θεὸς ἐδοξάσθη ἐν αὐτῷ).

3. GLORY – HOW GOD IS WORSHIPED

3.1. IN THE SON

- Heb 1:3 He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. (δς ῶν ἀπαύγασμα τῆς δόξης καὶ χαρακτὴρ τῆς ὑποστάσεως αὐτοῦ)
- 2Cor 4:6 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of <u>the knowledge of the glory of God</u> in the face of Jesus Christ (πρός φωτισμόν τῆς γνώσεως τῆς δόξης τοῦ θεοῦ ἐν προσώπω [Ίησοῦ] Χριστοῦ).

3.2. ATTITUDES

3.2.1. HUMILITY, FEAR

- Is 40:4-5 Every <u>valley shall be lifted up</u>, and <u>every mountain and hill be made low</u>; the uneven ground shall become level, and the rough places a plain. ⁵ And the glory of the LORD shall be revealed (וְאֵלָה כְּבוֹד יְהוָה), and all flesh shall see it together, for the mouth of the LORD has spoken."
- Jos 7:19 Joshua said to Achan, "My son, <u>give glory</u> (שִׁים־נָא כְבוֹד) to the LORD God of Israel
- Ps 29:1 O heavenly beings, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength (לַיהוָה בְּנֵי אֵלִים הְבוּ לֵיהוָה כְּבוֹד וָעוֹ)
- Rev 14:7 "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come (φοβήθητε τὸν θεὸν καὶ δότε αὐτῷ δόξαν, ὅτι ἦλθεν ἡ ὥρα τῆς κρίσεως αὐτοῦ)

3.2.2. WONDER, ADMIRATION

2Thes 1:9-10 ...the Lord and ...the glory of his might, (τῆς δόξης τῆς ἰσχύος αὐτοῦ) ¹⁰ when he comes on that day to be glorified in his saints (ἐνδοξασθῆναι), and to be marveled at (θαυμασθῆναι) among all who have believed,

3.2.3. **PRAISE**

Ps 66:1-2 Shout for joy to God, all the earth; ² sing the glory of his name; give to him glorious praise! (הָרִיעוּ לֵאלֹהִים כָּלֹ-הָאָרֶץ ² וַמָּרוּ כְבוֹד-שָׁמוֹ שִׁימוּ כָבוֹד הְהָלָתוֹ)

4. TO REMEMBER

- The glory of God is his Being as it is known to his creatures.
- The glory of God is revealed in everything God does, from creation through providence in history to salvation.
- The glory of God can be appreciated only in humility. We can measure our knowledge of it by our response (admiration, excitement, thrill, praise).
