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0. INTRODUCTION

- The Gospel is best "explained" by a childlike experience of trust... learned words may just complicate it
- Lecturing on the Gospel may be compared to lecturing on metabolism when you are hungry... giving lecture instead of giving of food...

0.1. WHAT KIND OF LECTURE/DEFINITION?

- $\epsilon \dot{\nu} \alpha \gamma \gamma \acute{\epsilon} \lambda \iota o \nu \rightarrow$ the literary form \rightarrow the four gospels
- $\epsilon \dot{\nu} \alpha \gamma \gamma \dot{\epsilon} \lambda \iota o \nu \rightarrow$ the news of the Yeshua Hamashiach whom we call Jesus Christ...
- "first aid" definition → Believe in Jesus Christ and you will be saved...
- "<u>historical</u>" definition → In I Cor 15:3-4, Paul introduces the gospel he "received:" "...that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures."

"theological" definition → Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek

- "psychological" definition → 1Cor 1:18 For the word of the Cross is to them that are perishing foolishness, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
- "worldview" definition → in the context of available knowledge of reality...

0.2. THE GREEK WORD

• $\epsilon \dot{\upsilon}$ αγγέλιον \rightarrow "good news" \rightarrow a reward for a good news

There are many uses of this word that show this but the most famous is that of the the Priene Inscription and its date of 9 BC puts it right into the context of the New Testament happenings and writers minds. The Priene Inscription reads in part, \rightarrow "Since Providence... has set in most perfect order by giving us <u>Augustus</u>, whom she filled with virtue that he might benefit humankind, sending him as a **savior** [$\sigma\omega\tau\eta\rho$], both for us and for our descendants, that he might end war and arrange all things, and since he, Caesar (and inherent from this **Lord**), by his appearance... surpassing all previous benefactors, and not even leaving to posterity any hope of surpassing what he has done, and since the birthday of the god [τ 00 θ 800] Augustus was the beginning of the good tidings [$\epsilon\dot{\nu}\alpha\gamma\gamma\dot{\epsilon}\lambda\iota\sigma\nu$] for the world that came by reason of him..."

- (Diodorus Siculus) θεοῖς εὐαγγέλια θύσας
- Announcement of a victory (Marathon runner 490 BC → Νική)

0.3. BIBLICAL WAR

- → What kind of war is THE GOSPEL talking about?
- ... between heaven and hell → fall of angels → fall of man → Satan "god" of this world...

0.4. KIERKEGAARD'S CLOWN

• [Heine Wintermärchen] "Den Himmel überlassen wir / Den Engeln und den Spatzen."

[KIERKEGAARD Either/Or I, p. 30] In a theater, it happened that a fire started offstage. The clown came out to tell the audience. They thought it was a joke and applauded. He told them again, and they became still more hilarious. This is the way, I suppose, that the world will be destroyed-amid the universal hilarity of wits and wags who think it is all a joke.

1. WAR SITUATION

• **John 8:44** [the devil]... He was a murderer from the beginning, and has nothing to do with the truth, because there is no truth in him. ...he is a liar and the father of lies.

1.1. THE LIES (...WE LIKE)

1.1.1. ANTHROPOCENTRISM

- [PHILOSOPHY] Man in the centre
- God is under suspicion → or outright evil

1.1.2. INDIVIDUALISM

- [ETHICS] "self" in the centre
- God should solve MY situation regardless of others

1.1.3. SCIENTISM

- [EPISTEMOLOGY] belief in scientific methods
- God should persuade me of his truth without a necessity of my being changed

1.1.4. SECULARISM

- [RELIGION] life-fulfillment NOW
- God should give me all I desire in this life

1.2. REBELLION

- → "God in the Dock" (C. S. Lewis)
- Against the RULE of God (Law)
- Against the WORK of God (creation)
- Against the CHARACTER of God (idolatry)

1.3. DETRACTIONS

- Entertainment
- Workoholism
- Media

Once he was in the street the battle was won. 2. VICTORY OF GOD

2.1. MESSIAH

- against pluralistic/individualistic/anythinggoes self-salvation
- ADAM \rightarrow the head of old mankind \leftrightarrow Jesus Christ \rightarrow the head of new mankind
- Jesus of Nazareth → declared the Son of God through the RESURRECTION

2.2. SACRIFICE (THE CROSS)

- the inevitability of DEATH (**Rom 6:23 7:1** For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.)
- the death of the MESSIAH → the death of all mankind (John 12:32 And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.)

2.3. RESURRECTION (NEW WORLD)

eternal life → more than this life prolonged indefinitely

3. ANNOUNCING VICTORY

• $κήρυγμα \rightarrow$ the authority of the ACT of proclaiming

3.1. PRONOUNCING A JUDGMENT

• vour master – the devil – has been defeated

[William TEMPLE *Reagings in John's Gospel*] The offer of salvation involves <u>judgement</u> and (for those who refuse the offer) <u>condemnation</u>. For this is the [process of judgement, that the light is come into the world, and men loved rather the darkness than the light. We recall the words of the Prologue: There was the light, that lighteth every man, coming into the world (i, 9). **No greater gift can be offered to men**; yet many refuse it. They <u>loved the darkness rather than the light</u>. That is their choice; there is nothing worse that can be done to them after that.

3.2. INVITATION TO JOIN THE VICTORIOUS SIDE

→ REPENTANCE → confess sin; receive forgiveness from Christ...

waiting for Parousia

3.3. FOLLOWING CHRIST

- communion with Christ ...NOW (**Rom 14:17** ...(1) righteousness and (2) peace and (3) joy in the Holy Spirit)
- suffering ...NOW
- Mt 10:38 And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me
- Mt 16:24 Then Jesus told his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me

3.4. THE PAROUSIA

• **John 14:1-3** "Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. ² In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also

4. TO REMEMBER

- The Gospel speaks of the victory of Jesus.
- The Gospel makes us choose sides it's either God or Satan, either heaven or hell.
- The Gospel gives hope and power to wait for the Second Coming of Jesus to finalize his work of salvation.
