

EVANGELICAL THEOLOGY AND PHILOSOPHY: Improving a Difficult Relationship presents an approach to philosophy from the point of view of evangelical theology. It describes the ways of using philosophy in Christian apologetics and at the same time could be a guide to the successful study of philosophy by theologians.

PAVEL HANES has PhD in Theology from Comenius University, Bratislava. He is a professor of Systematic Theology and Apologetics at Matej Bel University, Banská Bystrica, Slovakia, where he has worked since its founding in 1993 as Slovakia's first freely evangelical department of theology and missiology. He has worked with the Slovak Bible Society to produce a translation of the book of Job and also spent ten years as a pastor prior to his academic career. Pavel grew up in communist Czechoslovakia where his faith and critical thinking developed in the context of an oppressive, state-enforced atheism, leading him to cherish the power of ideas.
