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0. INTRODUCTION

0.1. REPENTANCE \rightarrow JOY OF FORGIVENESS

- Ps 51:8(10) Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice.
- Ps 51:12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.
- 1Pt 1:8-9 Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory (ἀγαλλιᾶσθε χαρᾶ ἀνεκλαλήτω καὶ δεδοξασμένη), 9 obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.
- Rom 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of (1) righteousness and (2) peace and (3) joy in the Holy Spirit
- **Rom 12:11-13** Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in <u>spirit</u>, serve the Lord. ¹² **Rejoice in hope**, be patient in tribulation, be constant in <u>prayer</u>. ¹³ Contribute to the needs of the saints ... [GOODWIN] To do all out of a sense of his excellency and glory that is in himself, this is to <u>glorify</u> him. But to do all out of a sense of his mercies to us, and our obligement unto him, this is <u>thankfulness</u>. (*A*

0.2. JOY OF SALVATION \rightarrow THANKFULNESS

- **Heb 13:14-15** For here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come. ¹⁵ Through him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of **praise** to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name
- Acts $8 \rightarrow joy$ in Samaria
- **Acts 10:46** For they were hearing them speaking in tongues <u>and extolling God</u> (μεγαλυνόντων τὸν θεόν).

0.2.1. THE DANGER OF INGRATITUDE

- **Dt 32:15** But Jeshurun grew <u>fat</u>, and <u>kicked</u>; you grew fat, stout, and sleek; then he forsook God who made him and <u>scoffed</u> at the Rock of his salvation (Jakub jedol a nasýtil sa, stučnel miláčik a spriečil sa, stučnel, vykŕmil, vypásol sa; zanechal Boha, svojho Tvorcu, <u>pohrdol</u> Skalou svojej spásy)
- Nu 14:22-23 none of the men who have seen my glory and my signs that I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and yet have <u>put me to the test these ten times</u> and have not obeyed my voice, ²³ shall see the land that I swore to give to their fathers. And none of those who <u>despised me</u> (יְּכֶל-מְנַאֲצֵי) shall see it (všetci mužovia, ktorí videli moju slávu a moje znamenia, ktoré som robil v Egypte a na púšti, a pritom ma pokúšali desať ráz a nepočúvali môj hlas, ²³ neuvidia krajinu, ktorú som prísahou sľúbil vašim otcom)
- → Rom 1:21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him (οὐχ ὡς θεὸν ἐδόξασαν) as God or give thanks to him (ἢ ηὐχαρίστησαν), but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened

0.2.2. PROTECTION FROM INGRATITUDE

- 1Thes 5:18 give thanks in all circumstances (ἐν παντὶ εὐχαριστεῖτε); for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you
- Eph 5:20 giving thanks <u>always and for everything</u> to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ
- Col 2:7 rooted and built up in him and <u>established</u> in the <u>faith</u>, just as you were taught, <u>abounding</u> <u>in thanksgiving</u> (περισσεύοντες ἐν εὐχαριστία).
- Col 3:15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful (καὶ εὐχάριστοι γίνεσθε)
- **Col 3:17** And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

0.3. THANKSGIVING \rightarrow PRAYER

• Col 4:2 Continue steadfastly in <u>prayer</u>, being watchful in it with <u>thanksgiving</u> \Rightarrow <u>motivated</u> by what you have <u>received</u>

1. FELLOWSHIP IN THE SPIRIT

- (*koinos*), common, communal; (*koinoo*), make common or impure, defile, profane; (*koinoneo*), share, have a share in, participate in;
- fellowship → communication; sharing; partnership...
- 2Cor 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the <u>fellowship</u> of the Holy <u>Spirit</u> be with you all (ἡ κοινωνία τοῦ ἀγίου πνεύματος μετὰ πάντων ὑμῶν)
- Phil 2:1 So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any <u>participation in the Spirit</u> (εἴ τις κοινωνία πνεύματος), any affection and sympathy → complete my joy by being of the same mind
 - → objective/subjective genitive

1.1. FELLOWSHIP WITH THE TRINITY

1John 1:3-4 ...that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have <u>fellowship</u> (ἵνα καὶ ὑμεῖς κοινωνίαν ἔχητε μεθ' ἡμῶν) with us; and indeed our <u>fellowship</u> (ἡ κοινωνία δὲ ἡ ἡμετέρα) is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. ⁴ And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete

1.2. SPIRITUAL SHARING

- **LOVE** → **Rom 5:5** God's love (ἡ ἀγάπη τοῦ θεοῦ) has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us → objective/subjective genitive
- **INDIVIDUAL** → **Gal 2:19-20** I have been crucified with Christ. ²⁰ It is no longer I who live, but <u>Christ who lives in **me**</u>. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for **me**.
- CHURCH → 1Cor 10:16 The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a <u>participation in the blood</u> of Christ (οὐχὶ κοινωνία ἐστὶν τοῦ αἵματος τοῦ Χριστοῦ)? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ?

2. PRAYER IN THE SPIRIT

- Jude 1:20-21 But you, beloved, build yourselves up in your most holy faith; pray in the Holy Spirit; ²¹ keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life (ὑμεῖς δέ, ἀγαπητοί, ἐποικοδομοῦντες ἐαυτοὺς τῆ ἀγιωτάτη ὑμῶν πίστει, ἐν πνεύματι ἀγίω προσευχόμενοι, ²¹ ἑαυτοὺς ἐν ἀγάπη θεοῦ τηρήσατε προσδεχόμενοι τὸ ἔλεος τοῦ κυρίου ἡμῶν Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ εἰς ζωὴν αἰώνιον)
- Rom 8:26 Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words (ὑΩσαύτως δὲ καὶ τὸ πνεῦμα συναντιλαμβάνεται τῇ ἀσθενείᾳ ἡμῶν· τὸ γὰρ τί προσευξώμεθα καθὸ δεῖ οὐκ οἴδαμεν, ἀλλὰ αὐτὸ τὸ πνεῦμα ὑπερεντυγχάνει στεναγμοῖς ἀλαλήτοις)
- **Eph 2:18** For through him we both have <u>access in one Spirit to the Father</u> (ὅτι δι' αὐτοῦ ἔχομεν τὴν προσαγωγὴν οἱ ἀμφότεροι ἐν ἑνὶ πνεύματι πρὸς τὸν πατέρα)

2.1. TOGETHERNESS

- **Eph 2:22** In him you also are being <u>built together into a dwelling place for God</u> by the Spirit (συνοικοδομεῖσθε εἰς κατοικητήριον τοῦ θεοῦ ἐν πνεύματι)
- Mt 18:19-20 Again I say to you, if two of <u>you agree on earth</u> (συμφωνήσωσιν) about anything they ask, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. ²⁰ For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them.
- Heb 10:24-25 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together (μὴ ἐγκαταλείποντες τὴν ἐπισυναγωγὴν ἑαυτῶν), as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near

2.2. INTERCESSION

- Heb 7:25 Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them (εἰς τὸ ἐντυγχάνειν ὑπὲρ αὐτῶν)
- **Jas 5:16** Therefore, confess your sins to one another and <u>pray for one another</u> (εὕχεσθε ὑπὲρ ἀλλήλων), that you may be healed.
- Mt 5:44-45 But I say to you, Love your enemies and <u>pray for those who persecute you</u> (προσεύχεσθε ὑπὲρ τῶν διωκόντων ὑμᾶς), ⁴⁵ so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust.

2.3. SPIRITUAL FIGHT

• 2Cor 1:10-11 He delivered us from such a deadly peril, and he will deliver us. On him we have set our hope that he will deliver us again. You also must help us by prayer (συνυπουργούντων καὶ ὑμῶν ὑπὲρ ἡμῶν τῆ δεήσει → συν-υπουργέω), so that many will give thanks on our behalf for the

blessing granted us through the prayers of many.

3. TO REMEMBER

- The response to forgiveness is joy and *gratitude* that leads to thanksgiving/prayer.
- The fellowship in the Holy Spirit creates desire for communication, togetherness, prayer.
- Prayer in the Spirit is the strongest protection of salvation and the strongest weapon for the spreading of the Kingdom of God.
